

### LANGUAGE PLACEMENT

- THE PLACEMENT IS ONE TOOL TO HELP YOU FIND THE BEST MATCH FOR YOUR BACKGROUND.
  - You can take the French, German, Russian, and Spanish placements up to 5 times within a 7-day window.
  - The Center for World Languages and Cultures (CWLC) recommends students take the French and Spanish placement 2-3 times. The highest score will be the one that determines placement.
  - Other language placements cannot be taken more than once.
