- First-time users should complete all of the Registration fields towards the bottom of the screen. In the first 3 fields provide your first name, last name and DU email address.
- In Optional Field 1, provide your affiliation (Student, Faculty, Staff or Volunteer).
- In Optional Field 2, provide the name of the department or program (e.g., Facilities, Club Sports, Undergrad Admissions, etc...).
- After all fields are completed, click "Register," and follow the instructions in the email you receive from United Educators.

- After you log in, select the course(s) you would like to complete, and follow the on-screen instructions.
