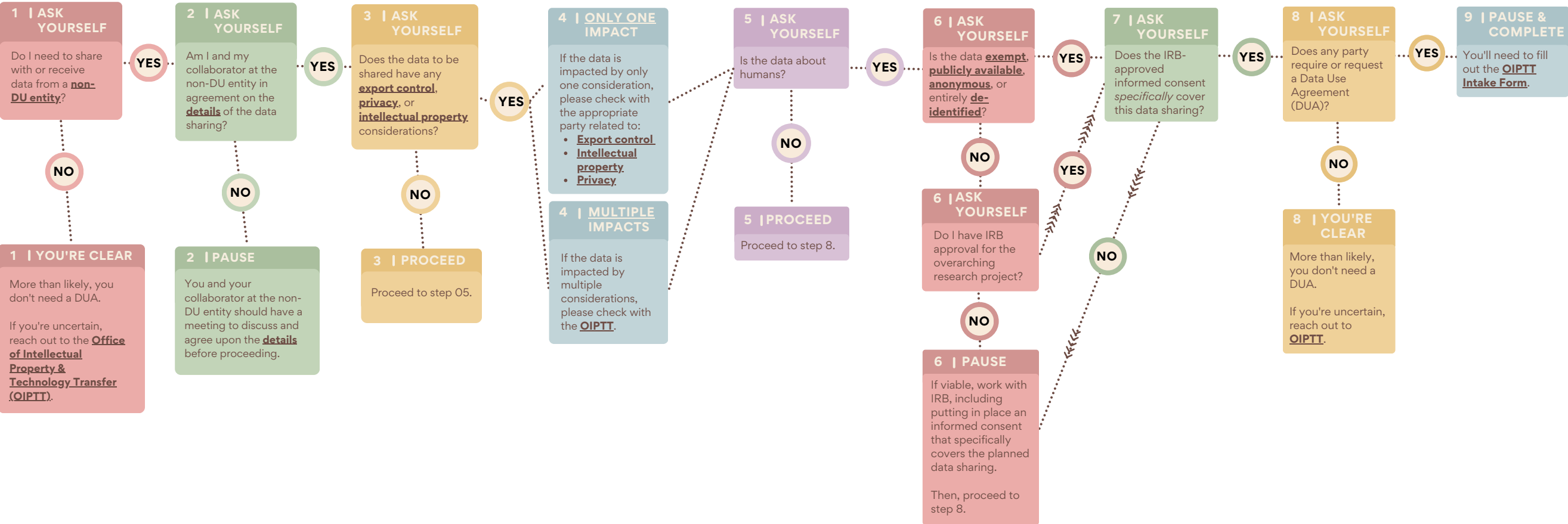


Data Use Agreement Flowchart

E.g., data available for purchase by the general public, data that is searchable online, data available through libraries, & data available to the general public upon registration or signing a use agreement.</p> <p>Anonymous - Data collected in such a way that it was & remains impossible to trace the data or information collected back to the research participant from whom data was obtained. I.e., no one could ever identify any given research participant, by any means. Note that this means coded data, data stored with informed consent forms, data points that are uniquely revealing about an individual's identity, & data collected in person or using audio/video mediums are not anonymous data.</p> <p>De-identified: The dataset does not contain any identifiable information, but there exists a way to link the information back to identifiable information (somewhere, in any form).</p>	<p>OIPTT: schedule a meeting: https://tinyurl.com/cstyfkem</p>	<p>OIPTT Intake Form - please email techtransfer@du.edu</p>
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
