- Students can (and should!) apply to Honors before committing to DU.
- Honors does not see students' general DU application. Honors application scores are primarily based on the five short essays.
- The majority of Honors students are able to double major *and* study abroad.
- Because Honors housing is optional, students can do Honors alongside the Leadership Program (PLP) or a Living/Learning Community (LLC).
